50 children from the LAMP program running in the organisation visited Pandit Sukhlalaji Lok Vidyalaya Matrudhara - Maidhar on 05-03-2025. Here the children tried their hand at science experiments and field games. Keeping in mind the possibility that every child is a scientist, children are being shaped here with an innovative education system.



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Under the LAMP program, a “District Level Consultation” program of SMC-PRI and community members was organized on 12/03/2025 at Amreli. They were taken to visit SEWA Trade Facilitation Center, Ahmedabad, Shivganga Gurukul, Dharampuri - Madhya Pradesh and SAHAJ - Dhahod. Here they gained practical knowledge for starting & building business from local women.



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Celebration of International Women's Day and 'Walk for Her' – A Powerful Initiative for Women's Health

On the special occasion of International Women's Day 2025, Ashirvad Foundation organized the 'Walk for Her' event at Lathi as part of its outreach efforts. Through this unique initiative, women who contributed 5,000 steps were offered free medical check-ups and breast mammography screenings by the foundation. During the event, a total of 63 women, along with Aashirvad Foundation representative Meetaben and members of the Lathi Cluster Team, participated in the rally. The steps donated were recorded via a mobile application, and certificates were awarded to encourage and recognize the participants' contributions to this noble cause. Additionally, awareness sessions on cancer prevention and early detection were conducted to educate women and inspire them to take proactive steps toward their health. This meaningful initiative delivered a strong message of health and empowerment, serving as a stepping stone toward a happier and healthier future for women.



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Under the Better Cotton program run by the organization, activities like 638 Rapid Soil Testing, 50 Green Cook Stove, distribution of Calendar, Biochar Demo- 6, labour's meetings, visit of Natural Input Center, LG Farmer Meeting, Weekly Meeting, Celebration of World Women's Day, Celebration of World Water Day, Capacity Building Trainings were conducted during the month.



Organisation team members linkages with KVK Amreli and organised off campus training at Lathi (05/03/2025), Babara (11/03/2025) and at Pir Khijadiya (12/03/2025) for making food and Bakery items. Total 136 women participated in this training. Expert Nehaben Tiwari taught women how to make roti pizza and ragi laddu. Women had a lot of fun. The women had a lot of fun. They learned the importance of ragi and how to make pizza at home. Now the women will make it themselves at home.



Two days training workshop cascaded to PU team on Understanding certification requirement & Reflecting on the knowledge acquired in 2024-25 through activities and capacity building at Nagpur on 19th & 20th March 2025. PU team members were presented in this workshop.



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In water harvesting activities, this month due to renovation of 5 check dams in 4 villages of Rajkot district, a significant water harvesting capacity will rise up to 184472 cubic meters. The Farm Outlet and Farm Banding structures have been successfully completed in 3 villages, covering a total area of 72.32 acres.



We successfully completed the plantation activity across 6 villages with strong community support, including contributions from the Yuva group, Gram Panchayat, and other NGOs. The initiative covered a total area of 6.28 hectares. A leveraged amount of Rs. 6,15,000/- was supported for this activity. This effort aims to enhance environmental sustainability.



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We have provided support to the Bhadva Farmers Producer Company by offering two technological solutions for the installation of grinding, packaging, and printing machines. This initiative is designed to enhance the efficiency and productivity of local chili processing. The new machines will improve product quality, increase production capacity, and streamline operations. This support is expected to boost the livelihoods of local farmers and strengthen the community's agricultural value chain.



A total of 76 women across 8 villages are being supported with Kota stone imitation tables to enhance their jewelry-making work.



Total 374 women and 5 men are being supported with drinking water tanks for animals, SSS-AI, and Azola beds to improve animal health and enhance milk productivity.



We conducted a livelihood training program on animal rearing best practices for 205 women across 5 villages, in collaboration with the BAIF organisation.



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We have completed the Digital Literacy Programme with 403 women in 10 villages of Gondal area.



From Reliance Foundation Operational Head Nitinbhai and Arvindbhai, DPM (Rajasthan team) visited the organization on 31st March 2025.



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Reliance Foundation held live online interaction with beneficiaries of the work area on the occasion of 'World Water Day' on 22 March 2025.
